**SUBJECT: February 2012 Advisory Committee Summary Report**

**RECOMMENDATION**

Accept the monthly Summary Report for the Technical, Citizens, Bicycle/Pedestrian, and Regional Road Impact Fee Advisory Committees.

**SUMMARY**

The RTC has two citizen advisory committees that provide input on a wide range of policy and planning issues as well as key planning documents and the RTC Budget. The Committees are the Citizens Advisory Committee (CAC) and the Bicycle/Pedestrian Advisory Committee (BPAC). The RTC Board approves appointments to the advisory committees. The agenda and minutes of each advisory committee are provided to the RTC Board.

The RTC has the Technical Advisory Committee (TAC). The TAC includes local public works directors, community development directors, and staff from other key agencies. The agenda and minutes of this committee are provided to the RTC Board.

The RTC also has the Regional Road Impact Fee Advisory Committee (RRIF TAC) which was created to oversee and advise the local governments regarding land use classification assumptions and the Capital Improvements Plan (CIP) used in the impact fee program. The RRIF TAC consists of three representatives from each local entity, two RTC representatives, and four private sector members who are appointed by the RTC Board. The agenda and minutes of this committee are provided to the RTC Board.

This memorandum summarizes comments along with any action taken by the RTC advisory committees related to items on the February 17, 2012, RTC Board agenda.

## **FISCAL IMPACT**

There is no fiscal impact associated with this agenda item.

## **ADDITIONAL BACKGROUND**

The following describes key actions and comments received from the RTC advisory committees.

### **Technical Advisory Committee (TAC)**

The TAC met on February 1, 2012. The Committee received presentations on the Nevada Department of Transportation (NDOT) *Connecting Nevada Plan* and the I-80 Design Build project. The TAC was given updates on the proposed RTC RIDE service change concepts; the Job Access/Reverse Commute (JARC) and New Freedom projects process; and the 2035 Regional Transportation Plan (RTP).

### **Citizens Advisory Committee (CAC)**

The CAC met on February 1, 2012. The Committee received a presentation on the I-80 Design Build project. The Committee discussed pedestrian and bicycle facilities and safety in light of the recent incidents in the community. The CAC was given updates on the proposed RTC RIDE service change concepts; the Job Access/Reverse Commute (JARC) and New Freedom projects process; and the 2035 Regional Transportation Plan (RTP).

### **Bicycle/Pedestrian Advisory Committee (BPAC)**

The BPAC met on January 25, 2012. The new regular members were introduced and the BPAC discussed that three alternate member positions would now be open and advertising for applications would begin soon. The final draft of the revised 2012 Bike/Ped Map was approved; the map will be at the printer in February and distributed in March. The Committee received updates on the 4<sup>th</sup> Street/Prater Way Corridor Study, the Plumb Lane project, the proposed RTC RIDE service change concepts and Sun Valley bike/ped improvements. The BPAC thanked Chris Louis for his service and wished him well on his retirement.
