Now you can track the next time your RTC RIDE bus will arrive with just the click of a mouse. While at home, work, school and any internet-friendly location, you can find out where your bus is in real time on a map. WebWatch helps you better plan your bus trip by using satellite and GPS-based technology to monitor a bus' location en route, giving you a list of expected arrival times.

Live Route Map

Follow the simple instructions for choosing a route. If you prefer to track only vehicles and not major stops along the route, click the check mark for major stops. To hide the vehicles, click the check mark for vehicles.

See the bus direction and its next timepoint when you place the pointer over the bus and click on it.

Be sure to refer to the **detour** list for current reroute information.

Note: If you do not see a bus on the map, it may be due to one of the following reasons:

- The map may be zoomed in too far. Zoom out to view the entire route.
- Service may not be offered at this time or on that day.
- Service may not be offered at this time in the direction that you have selected.
- The WebWatch website may have lost contact with The RTC RIDE's GPS system.

Live Arrival Times

WebWatch displays timepoints that are also shown on the printed and online schedules. Follow the simple instructions and click to get the next three arrival times.

ADA Website

For persons with disabilities, page navigation to get arrival times is automatic. Choose the route, direction you want to travel and the RTC RIDE stop.
