The Citizens Multimodal Advisory Committee (CMAC) met in the RTC 1st Floor Conference Room, 1105 Terminal Way, Reno. The meeting was called to order at 5:30 p.m.

ITEM 1. APPROVAL OF AGENDA

The agenda was approved as submitted.

ITEM 2. PUBLIC COMMENT

There was no public comment.

ITEM 3. APPROVAL OF THE DECEMBER 2, 2015 MEETING MINUTES

The minutes of the CMAC meeting December 2, 2015 were approved as submitted.

ITEM 4. PRESENTATION ON THE COMPLETE STREETS MASTER PLAN

RTC Senior Engineer, Howard Riedl gave a brief presentation on the Complete Streets Master Plan. A copy of the presentation attachment is available at the RTC Metropolitan Planning Department. He stated that data has been collected, utilized long range transportation plan for road treatments and public outreach through multiple Complete Streets community workshops for a final draft. Two Complete Streets

community workshops are scheduled, one on February 17, 2015 at 5:00 p.m. at Dilworth Stem Academy and another on February 23, 2015 at 5:00 p.m. at the Nevada Discovery Museum. Discussion followed.

ITEM 5. PRESENTATION ON THE NORTH VALLEYS REGION MULTIMODAL TRANSPORTATION STUDY

RTC Planner, Xuan Wang gave a presentation on the North Valleys Region Multimodal Transportation Study. A copy of the presentation is available at the RTC Metropolitan Planning Department. RTC is working close with Nevada Department of Transportation (NDOT) on this study. A workshop is scheduled for February 4, 2016 at O'Brien Stem Academy at 5:00 p.m. Discussion followed.

ITEM 6. PRESENTATION ON THE FY 2015 TRIP REDUCTION PROGRAM REPORT

RTC Trip Reduction Specialist, Carol Perry gave a brief presentation on the trip reduction program report based on the federal fiscal year. She indicated a trip matching program is available online for quick, convenient access to find carpool, vanpools, bike, walk, and transit buddies. She stated that a rebranding of RTC Vanpool program has been implicated and reorganized the subsidy structure with a flat dollar amount. Discussion followed.
