The Committee met in Suite 201, 1105 Terminal Way, Reno, Nevada. The meeting was called to order at 9:00 a.m. by Chair Bill Gall.

ITEM 1. APPROVAL OF AGENDA

The agenda was approved as presented.

ITEM 2. PUBLIC COMMENT

There was no response to the call for public comment.

ITEM 3. APPROVAL OF THE SEPTEMBER 3, 2014, MEETING MINUTES

ITEM 4. DISCUSSION AND RECOMMENDATION ON THE COORDINATED HUMAN SERVICES PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION PLAN

Tina Wu, RTC Senior Transit Planner, briefed the TAC on the Coordinated Human Services Public Transportation Plan (CTP). She asked the committee to review the document and send any comments to her and a final CTP should be submitted in November.

Following discussion, Dan Inouye made a motion to recommend approval of the Sun Valley Boulevard Corridor Study. Clara Lawson seconded. The motion carried unanimously.

Amy Cummings stated that the open house for the Sparks Boulevard Corridor Study would be held on Thursday, October 2, 2014 from 5 pm to 7 pm at Reed High School.

Coy Peacock stated that the draft study for the Spaghetti Bowl portion of the I-80 Corridor Study should be available for review by October 10, 2014. He also stated that the I-80 Corridor Study would also be available for review shortly and that a presentation would be made to the TAC. He also briefed the TAC on the upcoming County tours.

Christina Leach, FHWA, stated that the US DOT would be starting an initiative to improve bicycle and pedestrian safety with an 18 month campaign and that she would keep the TAC informed.
