



RTC RIDE REDUCED FARE FOR SENIOR CITIZENS

RTC RIDE offers a reduced fare program to all persons who are 60 years or older. The senior citizen fare is half of the adult RTC RIDE fare.

To apply for an RTC RIDE Senior Citizen ID card and enroll in the reduced fare program:

Complete Part 1 (reverse side).

Take the application and proof of your date of birth to an RTC RIDE ID Card Location listed below.

If RTC approves your application, your photo will be taken and you will be issued a photo RTC RIDE Senior Citizen ID card. Your ID card will be valid for 5 years and may be renewed. Show this ID card to the RTC RIDE coach operator each time you board the bus as proof that you are eligible for the senior citizen reduced fare.

The card and application process is free. The RTC reserves the right to review eligibility.

ID Cards are issued for free, replacement cards are \$5.00 each.
