Dear Resident/Property Owner:

The Regional Transportation Commission is currently in the design phase of a project known as Reno Consolidated 20-01 to rehabilitate and/or reconstruct the following streets: **Mayberry Drive** from Memory Lane to California Avenue, **California Avenue** from Hunter Lake Drive to Booth Street, and **West First Street** from North Sierra Street to Virginia Street. The project limits are shown on the map on the reverse side of this letter. The existing pavement condition will be evaluated and an appropriate rehabilitation design prepared. There will not be any widening of the existing roadways.

We are sending this letter as advance notification of the planned construction, which is scheduled to begin summer of 2021.

Any property owner who is planning to install gas, water or sewer laterals, telephone or television cable, etc., which will require street trenching within the limits of the project, is requested to do so prior to construction. The purpose of this request is to avoid cutting into newly constructed pavements and the associated street cut penalties assessed by the City of Reno.

As part of the design process, we would also like an opportunity for local businesses, residents, and property owners to preview the scope of our work and to solicit comments regarding the important issue of traffic control. Due to the COVID-19 social distancing restrictions, we are unable to schedule an in-person public informational meeting. In its place, we are providing a Virtual Project Presentation that will be available from May 27 – June 30 where you can learn more about the project and submit your comments and questions. A post card will be mailed to you with additional information.
