RECOMMENDED ACTION

Recommend approval of the proposed Amendment No. 1 to the FFY 2021-2025 Regional Transportation Improvement Program (RTIP).

BACKGROUND AND DISCUSSION

RTC staff is proposing Amendment No. 1 to incorporate several projects that recently received funding through the RTC's Enhanced Mobility of Seniors & Individuals with Disabilities, Federal Transit Administration's Section 5310 Program. Projects funded through this program are included in the RTC's Coordinated Human Services Public Transportation Plan (CTP), a federally required document that guides the use of Section 5310 funds. In addition, the amendment will incorporate some scheduling changes and minor funding updates to some existing capital projects already included in the RTIP.

An air quality analysis for the proposed amendment was not required as the new 5310 transit projects are exempt from transportation conformity requirements.

The public comment period for the amendment began on July 30, and will close on August 19. A public hearing will be held at the RTC Board meeting on August 20.
