

How to Connect to Onboard Wi-Fi

If your wireless device is set to automatically detect available wireless networks follow these steps:

- 1. Click the wireless network icon in the Notification area of your desktop (where the time is displayed).
- 2. Click View Wireless Networks.
- 3. Select the wireless network that begins with RTC. Then Click Connect.
- 4. Open your browser to be directed to our splash page.

You can also connect using Microsoft's prescribed procedure for Windows:

- 1. Click Start/Settings/Control Panel.
- 2. Click Network and Internet Connections (in Classic View just go to step 3).
- 3. Double Click Network Connections.
- 4. Double Click Wireless Network Connection.
- 5. Click View Wireless Networks.
- 6. Select the wireless network that begins with RTC. Then Click Connect.
- 7. Open your browser to be directed to our splash page.
